2024 | Opt-In to Serving

Whether you've been serving for years, have recently joined a serving ministry, or thinking about signing up for the first time, EVERYONE is kindly requested to complete our new Opt-In to Serving Form for the 2024 year.



Things you might need to know about the planned new system:

ROTATIONS

For the majority of ministries we will create 3 teams (and pray that over time as our family grows, we can increase this number). Typically you'll be on 2 weeks in a row, which translates to 2 weeks on, 4 weeks off, which will simplify planning ahead in your own diaries.

MASTER ROSTER

A ministry-wide master roster will be published every 3 months. We will aim to publish at least 2 weeks before the next 3-month cycle to aid in your diary planning.

TEAMS

To discourage individual serving that fits in around your life, we want to encourage folk to serve God's family sacrificially in a community context, so all serving (where applicable) will now happen in teams! You will commit to serve alongside a team and build relationships with those you serve with.

PICK ONE THING!

Instead of serving across multiple ministries, we want to encourage folk to pick 1 ministry, to invest in it, strive for excellence, and build relationships with your team members. *(if you desperately want to*

do a 2nd thing, come chat to us and let's think it thru together.)

COMMIT FOR THE YEAR

Over-commitment and sometimes extended periods of commitment lead to grumpiness and frustration, so we encourage folk to sign up for a year at a time, with a view to reviewing at the end of each annual cycle. Our cycles will run 1st February to 31 January each year.

SUNDAYS TOO TRICKY? Then choose something else!

We understand that its tricky for some folk to commit to a regular Sunday routine because of work etc. No problem! There are plenty of other ways to serve God's family regularly - so look out below for the Sunday vs non-Sunday ministry opportunity lists.

BREAKING THE MOULD!

Tea duty is not just for gals! Consider breaking the mould and serving in a different area. We need men to help with Sunday School, Teen Ministry, Tea Ministry etc. Or, if you're married, consider serving somewhere together, which certainly makes committing to a team logistically simpler.
